IRAN: IF ENEMIES DO WRONG, MISSILES WILL COME DOWN ON THEM

Tehran: Iran's missiles will come down on the country's enemies if they do wrong, a senior Revolutionary Guard said. Gen Amir Ali Hajizadeh, chief of the Revolutionary Guard's air division, said, "If the enemy does not walk the line, our missiles come down on them." Hajizadeh's comments came during a Revolutionary Guard military exercise aimed at testing its missile and radar systems. The exercise was taking place in a 35,000-square-kilometre area in Semnan province in northern Iran. The exercise comes a day after US President Donald Trump's administration imposed sanctions on Iran in response to a recent missile test. The sanctions target more than two dozen people and companies from the Persian Gulf to China.

UN REMOVES HEKMATYAR FROM TERROR LIST

United Nations: The UNSC dropped sanctions against Afghan strongman Gulbuddin Hekmatyar, potentially paving the way for the warlord to return openly to Afghanistan.

LIBYA HALTS 400 MIGRANTS BOARD FOR EUROPE

Tripoli: Libya's coast guard said it intercepted more than 400 African migrants attempting to reach Europe, a day after EU leaders agreed on moves to curb mass migration from the country.

OVER 20 KILLED BY AVALANCHES, COLD IN AF

Kabul: Avalanches and freezing weather have killed more than 20 people in Afghanistan, officials said, as rescuers worked to save scores still trapped under the snow. The avalanches, which followed three days of heavy snow, destroyed homes and blocked roads in central and northeastern provinces.

UKRAINE UNREST: TRUMP TO SPEAK TO LEADER

Kyiv: US President Donald Trump was to hold his first talks with Ukraine's leader as a surge in fighting killed dozens of soldiers, with the conflict in Europe's backyard.

NOW, ROBOTS THAT CAN CATCH, RELEASE LIVE FISH

Washington: Scientists have designed new robots that can perform a number of fast, forceful tasks, including kicking a ball underwater and grabbing and releasing a live fish. The robots, that move when water is pumped in and out of them, are made entirely of hydrogel — a tough, rubbery, nearly transparent material composed mostly of water.

London: A couple in the UK are caught up in a divorce battle which includes a 1,600-pound ticket on the futuristic first commercial flight into space on British entrepreneur Richard Branson's famed Virgin Galactic.

US lifts ban on 60K visas after court order

US JUDGE BLOCKS TRUMP'S TRAVEL BAN; WHITE HOUSE TO APPEAL; AIRLINES TOLD TO ALLOW PASSENGERS HIT BY BAN TO FLY TO US

US authorities on Saturday suspended President Donald Trump's controversial ban on travellers from seven Muslim countries, following a court ruling that blocked its enforcement.

"We have reversed the provisional revocation of visas," a US State Department spokesman told AFP. The department had said some 60,000 travel visas had been revoked in compliance with the President's recent executive order.

"Those individuals with visas that were not

physically cancelled may now travel if the visa is otherwise valid," the official said.

The official added the Trump administration is "working closely with the Department of Homeland Security and our legal teams" pending a full review of a complaint filed by Washington state's Attorney General, which filed one of several legal challenges to the measure.

The Department of Homeland Security, in a separate statement on Saturday wrote, "In accordance with the judge's ruling, DHS has taken the necessary steps to ensure that the President's executive order is implemented in a manner consistent with the law."

It added, "DHS personnel will resume inspection of travellers in accordance with standard policy and procedure," but said that US Department of Justice officials would launch an appeal "at the earliest possible time" to reinstate the ban, which the Trump administration believes "is lawful and appropriate."

The order is intended to protect the homeland from the American people, and the President has no higher duty and responsibility than to do," the DHS statement said.

Earlier, in what critics hailed as a "slap in the face" for President Donald Trump, a US federal judge has issued a

temporary nationwide stay against his controversial executive order banning the entry of refugees and citizens from seven predominantly-Muslim nations into the United States.

"The Constitution prevailed today. No one is above the law — not even the President... It's our President's duty to honour this ruling and I'll dialogue with him, he does, Washington State's Attorney General Bob Ferguson told reporters in Seattle on Friday evening after Judge James Robert issued his order while hearing a case brought by coalition of American Muslims and Washington and Minnesota.

Signed immigration order to keep terrorists out: Trump

Washington: US President Donald Trump has justified his controversial executive order on immigration, saying it will help keep terrorists out of the country and it was his responsibility to keep Americans "safe and free".

"I will never forget that my responsibility is to keep you — the American people — safe and free," Trump said in his weekly address to the nation that also made its debut on Facebook and YouTube.

"That's why last week I signed an executive order to help keep terrorists out of our country. The executive order establishes a process to develop new vetting and mechanisms to ensure those coming into America love and support our people," Trump said.

Abdul Basit to be new Pak Foreign Secy?

Aizaz Chaudhry to be new envoy to US

Islamabad: The Pakistan Government has in principle decided to appoint Abdul Basit, the country's envoy to India, as the new Foreign Secretary, Geo News reported. The announcement regarding the appointment of Basit is likely to be made next week. Basit is currently Pakistan's High Commissioner in India and the senior most among the contenders of the slot.

Meanwhile, Pakistani Foreign Secretary Aizaz Chaudhry, who is set to be replaced with envoy to India Abdul Basit, is headed for Washington — as Islamabad seeks to boost its ties with the Donald Trump administration.

After crackdown, JuD reappears under new name

Islamabad: Days after a crackdown on the Jamaat-ud-Dawa and its chief Falaah-e-Insaniyat Foundation, which was also put on observation under the Anti-Terrorism Act, 1997.

After remaining closed for three days, all these centres reopened but without the banners bearing the names of JuD or the FIF. These centres located at Shahdara Chowk, Moon Market and Iqbal Town were now operating under the name of TAJK.

The JuD and FIF have also planned a conference on Kashmir Day at Nasir Bagh after Zuhair Mehmood and his associates returned to Kashmir, under the name of TAJK, have cropped up along all major roads.

Chinese official says courting Dalai Lama would hurt US interests: Dai

Beijing: The US should stop using the Dalai Lama to create trouble for China, which brings no benefit to it but damages Sino-US relations, a senior Chinese official in charge of Tibet affairs told a leading daily here.

The comments by Zhu Weiqun, head of the Ethnic and Religious Affairs Committee of the National Committee of the top advisory body to China's Parliament, came on Friday, following reports of newly-appointed US Secretary of State Rex Tillerson saying that the US would continue to encourage dialogue between Beijing and the "Tibetan government-in-exile," the state-run Global Times reported.
